1 GOLDEN ISLES OF GEORGIA

We will enjoy a delightful luncheon (included) at the Jekyll Island Club—considered one of the most exclusive social clubs in America. After lunch we will tour quaint St. Simons Island and stroll on the grounds of the beautiful and historic Christ Church. 3 HISTORIC SAVANNAH/OLDE TOWN TROLLEY AND THANKSGIVING DINNER

We have a short drive north to America's first planned city, Savannah. This historic city sits on a high bluff overlooking the Savannah River. We hop aboard the Old Town Trolley to see the sights in Savannah—the largest National Historic Landmark area in the U. S. Visit the historic district and experience southern charm first-hand with a stroll along the cobblestone-paved Factors Walk and River Street, where old cotton warehouses have been converted into shops, taverns and restaurants. Your local tour concludes with a visit to the Andrew Low Home and Gardens. Learn the history of the start of the Girl Scouts and its founder, Juliette Low. This evening we will enjoy a Thanksgiving Dinner Cruise on the Savannah River aboard the Savannah Riverboat. There will be all the traditional favorites such as roasted turkey and dressing, honey glazed ham, sweet potatoes with praline topping, other fresh vegetables and casseroles and good ole holiday desserts topped off with delightful evening entertainment. **D**
