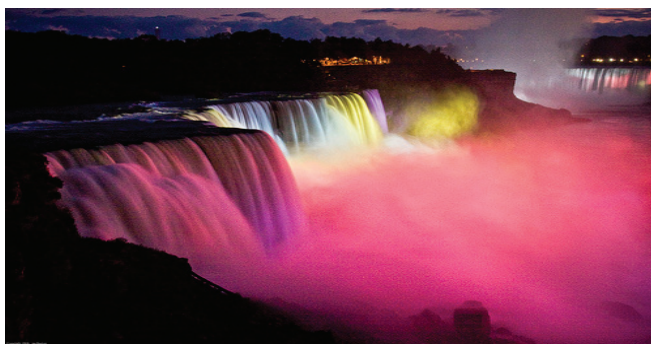

1 MINERAL WELLS, WEST VIRGINIA

This morning we board our deluxe motorcoach for an exciting winter holiday to Canada. After lunch in the Princeton area we will continue to Mineral Wells, West Virginia, for overnight.



2 & 3 NIAGARA FALLS ILLUMINATION

This morning we will depart Mineral Wells after breakfast and travel to Ontario's magnificent Niagara Falls—renowned as the "Honeymoon Capital of the World". The town stretches for about two miles along the Niagara River. The Winter Festival of Lights turns Niagara Falls into a winter wonderland, with over three million sparkling lights along a five mile route, new Niagara Falls ice skating at the Rink at the Brink, grand holiday displays throughout the city, and unique Niagara Falls events. Horseshoe Falls illuminated by the colored lights at night—spectacular doesn't begin to describe this sight. We will spend two nights at Niagara Falls and see all the sights. The Niagara Falls Winter Festival of Lights is proud to announce the launch of the newest wintertime Niagara Falls attraction, Rink at the Brink. Like the rink at Rockefeller Plaza in New York City but even more dramatic, the Rink at the Brink is situated a stone's throw from the "brink" of the Horseshoe Falls, offering breathtaking views and a magical outdoor Niagara Falls ice skating experience. Be sure to keep your eye out for favorites like the world's largest Canadian-American Flag display,



the Snowman Band, Canada's largest illuminated Menorah, a Teddy Bear Parade, as well as Royal Canadian Mounted Police displays located in front of the Niagara Parks Police building. The Niagara Parks Police building is also beautifully illuminated with its illumination choreographed to festive music. This brilliant demonstration occurs every 5 minutes. Thanksgiving Dinner is included at the Hilton Watermark Restaurant. There is not a bad seat in the house to view the falls illumination from your dinner table. After dinner we enjoy a leisurely drive through the Winter Festival of Lights.

4 & 5 OGLEBAY / WHEELING FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS

We continue our holiday tour as we depart Niagara Falls traveling to Wheeling, West Virginia where we will enjoy the Festival of Lights display at Oglebay Park. After dinner (included) this evening we will enjoy a leisurely drive through the Festival of Lights. The Oglebay Winter Festival of Lights, begun in 1985, has grown into the nation's largest holiday light show, attracting more than a million visitors per year. The Festival covers more than three hundred acres over a six mile drive throughout the Oglebay resort. More than seventy displays and over one million lights spread over 300 acres are featured in this celebration. Original display favorites in the Oglebay Winter Festival of Lights include the animated Snowflake Tunnel, a Candy Cane Wreath, The Twelve Days of Christmas, the massive Polyhedron Star, and Willard the Snowman, named for the TV weatherman Willard Scott who 'turned on' the lights in 1986. Directional Snoopys help guide visitors through the 6-mile tour. We will spend two nights in the Wheeling area. After driving through the six-mile display, we will see the life-size Nativity scene and its surrounding Christmas Tree Garden, as well as the elaborate holiday decorations at the Mansion Museum and Wilson Lodge. On Saturday evening we will see the Jamboree USA Show at the Capitol Music Hall. **D**
