1 MINERAL WELLS, WEST VIRGINIA

This morning we board our deluxe motorcoach for an exciting winter holiday to Canada. After lunch in the Princeton area we will continue to Mineral Wells, West Virginia, for overnight.

2 FROZEN NIAGARA—WHAT A SIGHT!

This morning we will depart Mineral Wells after breakfast and travel to Ontario's magnificent Niagara Falls—renowned as the "Honeymoon Capital of the World". The town stretches for about two miles along the Niagara River and is our destination for the night. Hopefully Horseshoe Falls will be frozen—spectacular doesn't begin to describe this sight. You will be amazed at the sight illuminated by the colored lights at night.



3 SIGHTSEEING NIAGARA / LONDON, ONTARIO

This morning we will see the sights at Niagara Falls and enjoy a delightful luncheon in the Skylon Tower. After lunch we continue through Hamilton and Woodstock, Ontario to London for our next overnight. Built around the Fork of the Thames Rivers, London is a charming city of over 350,000. London, also known as the Forest City, boasts miles of beautiful pathways and acres of rolling parkland. The home of Sir Frederick G. Banting, co-discoverer of insulin, this little city was originally set to be "New London" the capital of Upper Canada in 1793. Our home for the night is the Delta London Armouries Hotel—built within an authentic Armoury building, this modern hotel is known as one of London's most recognized landmarks. L

4 & 5 SAULT STE. MARIE, ONTARIO / SNOW TRAIN

We depart London this morning and travel to Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, where accommodations await us for the next two nights. Tomorrow is the day we've been waiting for. We will board our rail car at the Algoma Central Railroad for a journey that you will remember for some time. Here is a journey through the domain of the winter giant. This is a different look at Algoma



Central country, clad in its mantle of snow, adorned with sparkling diamonds of frost. Gone is the green of summer and the gold of fall. The white of winter is everywhere. The waterfalls and rocky cliffs—now masses of ice, the crystal clear air together with the snow laden branches of spruce and pine all combine to make this region truly a winter wonderland. We travel north from Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, through scenic Bellevue and Searchmont valleys, skirt the frozen shores of Algoma's many lakes and finally wind our way down to the floor of the famous "Agawa Canyon". All this can be experienced from the warmth of a picture window coach, nestled comfortably in your reclining seat with outside temperatures sometimes dropping well below zero. We will return to Sault Ste. Marie for the night. B L

6 CALL OF THE WILD MUSEUM / SLEIGH RIDE / ELK VIEWING/DINNER ELKHORN LOG CABIN

We depart Sault Ste Marie this morning traveling south crossing the Mighty Mac Bridge that connects Michigan's Upper and Lower Peninsulas on our way to Gaylord, Michigan to visit the Call of The Wild Museum. The museum displays more than 150 life-like North American game birds and wild animals such as beavers, elk and polar bears in their natural settings, complete with sound effects. After lunch we make our way into Michigan's wooded countryside to Hillman and the Thunder Bay Resort. Later this afternoon we board a horse-drawn sleigh for a ride through the snow-blanketed northern woods to view elk, deer and other wildlife (heavy blankets are provided). The sleigh delivers you to the charming "Elkhorn Log Cabin" where a superb 5-course gourmet dinner awaits. An Experience of a Lifetime! D

7 FRANKENMUTH /CABELA'S /DUNDEE, MICHIGAN

We depart Hillman this morning to begin our journey homeward. By mid-morning we arrive in the Bavarian town of Frankenmuth, Michigan for lunch (included) with time for shopping and browsing. We continue to Dundee, Michigan, for our last night. Our hotel is located next door to Cabela's—known today as the "World's Foremost Outfitters". L
