1 MARIETTA, OHIO

We depart Knoxville this morning traveling northeast through the Tri-Cities area of Tennessee before entering Virginia. At Wytheville we turn north and soon enter the Mountain State of West Virginia stopping in Beckley for lunch at Tamarack. Tamarack's striking, peaked red roof and attractively landscaped grounds draw half a million visitors annually into a welcome respite of visual beauty, Appalachian sounds, and distinctive aromas. It's a one-stop-shop for West Virginia culture, heritage, handcrafts, fine art, regional cuisine and music. Tamarack's world-renowned partner, The Greenbrier, provides signature dining which attracts guests for second helpings of delectable cuisine. After lunch we continue through West Virginia and into Ohio to Marietta, Ohio for overnight.

2 FROZEN NIAGARA—WHAT A SIGHT!

This morning we will depart Marietta after breakfast and travel to Ontario's magnificent Niagara Falls—renowned as the "Honeymoon Capital of the World". 4 & 5 WINTERLUDE / CRYSTAL GARDEN ICE CARVING / QUEBEC WINTER CARNIVAL

Winterlude, Ottawa's majestic winter carnival, is in full swing. Over 700 Blocks of ice have been transformed into a world of glittering art sculptures unlike anything you have ever seen. We continue to Quebec, for more winter fun. Canadians, you'll discover, don't just put up with winter, they revel in it. This joyous celebration features seventeen days of non-stop fun and activities including snow sculpture competitions, glittering night parades, a majestic ice palace, outdoor games, art shows and much, much more! There will be time to explore the Old City of Quebec. We will spend two nights in Quebec City.

6 EASTSIDE RESTAURANT / WOODSTOCK, VERMONT

We depart Quebec City this morning traveling southward crossing the St. Lawrence and southern Quebec Province entering Vermont at Newport for lunch (included) at the East Side Restaurant. After lunch we continue through Vermont to the quaint little town of Woodstock for shopping. Words like "romantic", "magical" and "historic" are often used to describe this quaint village that has been called "the prettiest small town in America". With a covered bridge in the middle of town, and stately homes surrounding the village green, it is easy to see why Woodstock has been called the "quintessential New England village". 7 YANKEE CANDLE / CHAMBERSBURG, PA

The Yankee Candle flagship store in South Deerfield is the Disney World of candles. You can literally lose yourself for hours in its winding, cavernous showrooms and among its tantalizing scents.
